## Correspondence

#### 1. Rick Gehman Resignation

Bruce Leisey informed the Planning Commission that Rick Gehman has resigned from the Clay Township Planning Commission. Rick has accepted a new job out of state.

#### Plan Review

1. Wildflower Commons - Request for Landscape Modification

Francesco Conigliaro, Representative of the Developer, reviewed the landscape modification request with the Planning Commission. The original landscape plan was designed in 2006. Since then some of the plantings were deemed not acceptable for the proposed property use.

After discussion, it was decided to allow the substitution of Honey Locust trees for Green Ash trees and substitution of Karl Forester grass for Red Barberry bushes. It was discussed that there is an insect concern with the Green Ash trees and the Red Barberry bushes contain large thorns.

It was noted, the replacement variants will not reduce the number of total plantings required.

The Planning Commission also allowed the Developer to replace the Respire Pear t	rees
with a variety that is hardy for this growing zone.
