Engineer's Report

1. Wanda and Marlin Martin SWMP – Update

Jennifer Mejia and Bob Lynn updated the Board of Supervisors on the Martin's SWMP and NPDES Permit status. They informed the Board of Supervisors that the property has been sold and contact will be made to the new owner for an update on the plans for the property.

2. 175 Ice House Hill Road – Request for Second Driveway Entrance Off Ice House Hill Road
