Engineer's Report

1. Discuss and Amend Zimmerman Streambank Restoration Bid Documents

1. Approve 2024 Budget

Bruce Leisey reviewed the budget with the Board.

Gary Landis made a motion, seconded by Keith Martin to approve the 2024 budget as printed in the December 20, 2023 Agenda Packet * The motion was unanimously approved.

2. Resolution to Transfer Monies from the General Fund to Capital Reserve Fund and amend 2023 budget.

There was discussion on the project 2023 Budget surplus for 2023. Bruce Leisey informed the Board a few income and expense items were still outstanding, but it appeared the 2023 budget cash surplus would be approximately \$300,000.

Gary Landis made a motion, seconded by Keith Martin, to authorize the Township Manager to transfer up to \$200,000 of the cash surplus from the General Fund to the Capital Reserve Fund * The motion was unanimously approved.

Mr. Leisey also noted Budget line item 01-414-300 Engineering Expenses in the General Fund was over budget by approximately \$107,000 because approximately \$87,165 of the overage was cost that were budgeted in the Capital Reserve Fund for the Woodcorner Road intersection project but paid out of the General Fund due to excess tax revenues received in 2023.
